The organization officially meets twice a year—at the Midwest Band Clinic and the summer meeting generally held in June. The organization provides many valuable articles in their publication *The Woman Conductor* that is published annually. WBDI provides eight different scholarships that can assist young ladies majoring in music. The

WDBI also awards the Summa Cum Laude and the Magna Cum Laude Award to outstanding schools in both middle and

high school with enrollments of less than 600.
