PRE-REGISTRATION - Now until July 16 at www.texasbandmasters.org.

- TBA is using a new software program to process member registration. Everyone must create a new profile, set a password, and process your payment using a credit card or printing and mailing an invoice with your check. All checks MUST BE POSTMARKED by July 2.
- Register before June 15 to take advantage of Early Bird pricing.
- Reserve your hotel room online. Hotels have FURTHER DISCOUNTED their convention rates from previous

years to encourage YOU to return to San Antonio this July! These special rates will be available until July 7. We have contracted with each hotel for a specific number of rooms and once those rooms are filled, these discounted rates will not be available to TBA attendees.


## ATTENDEE HEALTH AND SAFETY
