Using the Harlingen High School Jazz Ensemble as a demonstration group, the clinic will display limited instrumentation strategies as well as improvisation suggestions.

Instrumentation:

- 1. All should have opportunity to play America's music
- 2. Over instrumentated with authentic instruments, All play in rehearsal, alternate at Gigs
- 3. Reeds in Reeds, Brass in Brass
- 4. Tune Choices-be careful
- 5. Large group of mixed instruments-(re-arrange)
- 6. Smaller group of mixed instruments/unusual instruments (re-arrange)
- 7. Instrumentation should not dictate opportunity for performers
- 8. Balance Rhythm Section to horns
- 9. All performers must SWING!

Improvisation:

- 1. Building confidence using ability-level solos
- 2. Playing the blues using blues scales in question answer style
- 3. Teaching a chord or chord progression through a musical line
- 4. Importance of Singing licks (jazz phrases) and able to play what you sing
