Before the beginning

- Instruments delivered to school prior to the start of the year
- Name tags on cases
- Instrument and supplies, corks removed, reed guards loaded, supplies unbagged and placed in accessory compartment. Names in books.

At the beginning

- We spend 4-6 weeks w/o music or music stands
- Sit on floor to assemble/disassemble
- Master of the Alphabet
- Lines and Spaces chant
- Rote tunes: HCB, Merrily We Roll Along/Mary Had a Little Lamb, French Song, Lightly Row, Shark Song,
- Five note scales by rote: Bb, Eb, (F)

During the Year

- Teach everyday!!!
 - The only time we show a movie is the Friday we take the 7th and 8th graders to SA.
- Duets
 - o Follow That Man
 - Holiday duets (section features)
 - o I'm a Little Teapot
- How can you tell if a student is reading the music?
 - o Say and finger that line for me in rhythm
 - Stand behind the group and observe

Chromatic scale

- o Taught in chunks
- o Learn chromatic fingerings

- o Begin in January
- Say then play

Woodwinds

Flutes

- Headjoint tunes
 - HCB
 - Glissandos
- o Partner notes:
 - Low G to high D
 - Middle F to high/low Bb
 - Middle D to C...the hardest thing in the world!
 - Middle D/Eb...the only octave key notes on the flute
 - Trick names for 3rd octave notes
 - Evil E, Eb is everything, High F has no middle
- Octave studies
- o Ghosting:
 - Low B, C, C#, D, D#
- o Run the G

Clarinets

- Mouthpiece combo everyday
- Doodlette:
- Descending Eb and F concert scales
- Learn scales from top to bottom
- o Initial scale pattern

Saxophone

- o Learn G scale and scale of 3rds by rote early
- o Learn double Eb, F, and Ab concert scales spring semester.
- Teach chromatic fingerings as soon as opportunity in book occurs.

Brass

- o Add a note
- o Lip slurs
- o Chicowitz
- o Down low

- Most of this will be covered during Remington warm-up
- Warm-up #1: Ethan to the front to play
- o Eight on a hand
- Accent taps
