## SHOW DESIGN TIMELINE

Oct/Nov – Begin brainstorming concept/music  
Late Jan – Meet with arranger & drill designer  
Feb – Get copyright permissions & scores  
March – Begin arranging  
May – Show music arrives  
June – Student numbers to drill writer – per section/alternates  
July – Drill arrives

## CONCEPT

Thought goes into the WHOLE show package – music, drill, silks, visuals, props, t-shirt  
Know your kids (music must fit students strengths & stylistic talents)  
“COOL FACTOR” – Students/audience must buy into concept

## RETENTION/TRANSITION

8<sup>th</sup> graders perform at last home HS game  
Creating family environment from first meeting  
Reveal video for next year’s show  
Practice stand packets/show music last 2 weeks of school  
Full band rehearsal in June for following year’s band (8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>)  
“New” HS marching/concert instruments checked out to 8<sup>th</sup> graders for the Summer

## FUNDAMENTALS

When: Summer band, daily rehearsals, warm-up at contest

Marching Terminology

- Platform, toe to heel
- 45, parallel, feet position
- Block separation (rib cage from pelvis), Twist up (slides)
- Tondue (touch), pli  , rond de jambe, relev  

Attention (align shoulders over hips over ankles)

Horn carriage (tension free)

Slides, transitions, halts

Step size (initially not important, technique is more important)

### Warm-up drills (varying tempos)

- Blocks
  - 8 ct. block (left & right)
  - Around the world
  - Plus drill
  - Diamonds
  - Ice cream cone
- Across the floors (Relays)
  - Forward march
  - Backward march
  - Slide transitions

### REHEARSAL TECHNIQUES

Warm-up arc techniques – step-outs/mark time/visuals

Set

8 clicks/3 duts (5 & 6)

Paint sticks/coordinate sheets

Small copy of music

Sets marked in music

Point to your spots – halfway, half of that, etc.

Plus 1/Minus 1

Adjust/Stand in Check

### MISCELLANEOUS

Put *ALL* drill on the field during summer band, before start of school

Rehearse visuals in warm-up block/Don't be afraid to change if not working

Proactive sharing kids with other school activities

Music pass-off deadlines/No 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter break

Weekly rehearsals: Monday nights (3 hr.), Wednesdays after school (2 hr.), Fridays pre-game (30 min.)

Director led sectionals on Mondays after school (1 hr.)

During the first full week of Summer Band, Aug 3-7, lunch will be provided by the Princeton Band Boosters for \$20.00 (see Supply Form). It is necessary that all students remain at school during the lunch hour to eat, rest, and relax with friends. Students will be monitored and not allowed to leave campus during this time.

There will be many breaks for students to cool off and get a drink. It is also recommended that you get outside before camp starts, so the heat is not such a shock to your system. We will use the Multi-Purpose Facility during the hotter afternoon hours after lunch.

All wind and percussion students should come to Summer Band with ALL the show music memorized! The show music can be found at [www.princetonband.org](http://www.princetonband.org). Pass-offs will begin during Summer Band and continue into school. All wind and percussion students should come to Summer Band with ALL the show music memorized! No student will get their 3rd quarter break at football games until they have passed off the required music from the show. All wind and percussion students should come to Summer

Band with ALL the show music memorized! Students who do not pass off their music can be removed from the performing group and replaced by an alternate marcher. All wind and percussion students should come to Summer Band with ALL the show music memorized! There are certain items that students, as members of the marching band, will need to purchase from the band. Please be prepared to pay for these on August 1 when you arrive for HS Band Registration. Please see the Band Supply Form for a break down of these items. Guard uniform fees should have been paid by May 30. If not, be prepared to pay them on August 1.

A calendar has been included with this letter. Please use it when planning your work schedule, vacations, and other commitments. All high school band students will perform the district mandated drug screening of all students involved in extracurricular activities. Students will be required to test on a date usually scheduled during our practice time. More information will be provided once it becomes available.

There are also four forms included here that must be completed by the parents of every student participating in the Princeton High School Marching Band (the forms are front and back to save paper). Please return the completed forms when you arrive for Band Registration from 3pm-7pm on August 1 at the high school band hall. No student is allowed to travel or perform with the band until these completed forms are returned.

Again this Summer, we will have a Summer Band Mini-Camp on June 3 (3pm-6pm). This will be for everyone participating in the high school marching band. This will allow some time to remember what the marching fundamentals are and to help keep our "chops" in shape. This camp is required for all students in the marching band.
