### TEACHING LITERACY

- Empower students to teach themselves
- Critical listening
- Beginning Steps Building a solid foundation with no gaps
- Begin with the end in mind
- Set benchmark goals

### IT STARTS WITH BEGINNERS!

- Elementary to Beginner level what do they already know?
   Develop a relationship with elementary music teachers
- Standardize a vocabulary, counting system, etc.
  - o Elementary, Middle School, High School

### IT STARTS WITH BEGINNERS!

- Address all learning styles: visual, aural, tactile
- Change your mindset (and theirs!) it's only hard if you say it's hard!

### IN THE BEGINNING

- Teach posture and breathing from Day 1
  - How should they look when receiving information, chanting, playing, etc.?
- Keep a steady beat, with a metronome or popular songs (let students have input!)
- Musical Alphabet, hand staff, transfer to music
- Lines and Spaces teach stepwise and in the range they will see when they get to play

### IN THE BEGINNING

- Rhythm Racers goals and incentives
- Flash Cards and Timed tests (Mad Minute)
- Consider how many new notes you introduce at a time - Start with the first notes that they will actually play.

### **RECOGNIZING PATTERNS**

- Use lines from book and familiar songs to teach note recognition - students learn to identify concepts
- When looking at new lines, first compare them to prior knowledge - teach students to transfer information
- Scales, arpeggios, thirds, common intervallic motion that they'll see in music all through middle school
- Identifying sequences

## BEGINNER YEAR CONCEPTS

- Steps (whole/half), Skips (intervals)

- Accidentals
