CRMS Practice Techniques!

1. The Process

- Do this 1 or 2 measures at a time, then 2 or 4 measures at a time
- a. Count It
- b. Say it on your syllable
- c. Play it on one note d. Note name and finger
- e. Play it

2. Stacking

Start with one of two notes in rhythm After playing correctly 3 times, add one note Do this 1 or 2 measures at a time

3. Backwards stacking

Just like stacking only start at the end of a measure and add 1 note at a time before it

4. Zone In

Start on the note or rhythm that is giving you troubles Add one note to the end and play 3 times Then add one note before and play 3 times Then add another note to the end

5. Backwards

Play the line from right to left in rhythm (can also do this one measure at a time)

6. 4-3-2-1

Play each note as quarter notes 4 times Play each note as quarter notes 3 times Play each note as quarter notes 2 times Play each note as quarter notes 1 time

7. Rhythm Shuffle

Play each note for 4 beats (whole note) Play each note for 3 beats (dotted half note) Play each note for 2 beats (half note) Play each note for 1 beat (half note) Play each note for ½ beat (8th note)

8. Dial It Up

Increase the tempo by 1 or 2 clicks

9. Subdivide

Play the line dividing each note into 8th notes or 16th notes

10. Art Fun!

When playing a technical passage with all 8th notes or 16th notes, change the articulation

- a. Slur 2 tongue 2
- b. Tongue 2 slur 2
- c. Slur 3 tongue 1
- d. Tongue 1 slur 3
- e. Tongue 1 slur 2 tongue 1
