How to guide ALL students to success

Components of Success

1. Build a culture of excellence

Culture encompasses all aspects of the band program!

- 2. Creature your foundation-- build from the bottom up
- 3. Continue program growth
- 4. Director teamwork

Build a Culture of Excellence

- Culture starts with YOU!
 - Congratulations, you are already building a culture in your program by staying and working through the pandemic and its aftermath.
- Teach at one campus long enough to build up:
 - Inventory and library
 - Musical traditions
 - Social traditions
 - Community (band family)
- Have long term plans: 2 year, 3 year, 5 year...

Band must be integral part of school culture:

- Educate all stakeholders: parents, administrators, staff, community
 - Create a visible profile for your program
 - Communicate clearly and frequently
 - Engage in administrative tasks outside of your band hall
 - Perform for school AND community
- Connect with other programs
 - Full orchestra/8th Grade Band Night with HS
- Be an advocate for your band
- Make your classroom inviting
- Culture creates retention
- Balance music instruction with life skills
 - Excellence in musical performance
 - Excellence in caring for each other

2. Create Your Foundation: It all starts with beginners.

- Clear expectations, care for the individual
- Focus on fundamentals
 - o Tonal Concept
 - Rhythm understanding
 - o Technical facility of instrument
 - Performance

- How to be a band kid
- All students excel and move to the appropriate level in 2nd year of study (Non-Varsity/Varsity)
- Create sense of personal growth
- Individual success plus group success = high retention
- Peer tutoring
 - Band aides
 - Open practice to induce sense of community
- Non-competitive in year one
- Plan and teach with the end in mind (8th grade Varsity)
 - Gaps in varsity ability reflect gaps in beginner learning

Director Initiatives

- 1. Build the individual
- 2. Be a great role model
- 3. Teach students to love music like you do
- Be intuitive and flexible
- 5. Have empathy and compassion

3. Continue Program Growth: Keep the ensembles progressing.

- Group by ability
- High expectations but realistic to individual abilities
- MUST have performance opportunities for all ensembles
- Student involvement in music selection
- Make band fun
 - Super Saturday practice with fun and games afterward
 - Play games in rehearsal
 - Jaws of Joy, Don't Break the Chain, Rhythm Master, Last One Standing
 - Dress up days

4. Director Teamwork

- Find/build the right team
- Build mentorship from within the team or consultant
- Every director teaches ALL kids
- Create teamwork within ensembles and within staff
- Must be vertical alignment--team teach with the high school staff
- Co-teach sectionals
